NOTIFICATION

For the general information of all the exporters and importers, the Department is pleased to inform that the Government of the Republic of India has notified the following Land Customs Stations (LCSs) as additional exit/entry points in India for Bhutan's imports and exports:

1. Birpara has been notified as a LCS through the following authorized routes:
 - a. The route from Birpara (India) to Gomtu (Bhutan) through Dalmore and Makrapara Tea Gardens (India) and ;
 - b. The route from Birpara (India) to Pugli (Bhutan) through Dalmore and Lankapara Tea Gardens (India) are notified as authorized routes for Bhutan's trade with third countries.
2. Kamardwisa (Rangapani) LCS has been notified as a Permanent LCS;
3. Loksan LCS has been upgraded to Permanent LCS without any commodity restriction;
4. The road connecting Bokajuli in Assam to Motanga industrial state in Bhutan (under Darranga LCS) has been notified as authorized route for Bhutan's trade with third countries.
